PRACTICAL TRAINING PROGRAM

Gynecology and obstetrics STUDENT AFTER 5TH YEAR OF ENGLISH DIVISION Academic year/.....

After fifth year of studies, the Students are obligated to compete a **2-week (60 hours)** work placement. Number of **working hours per day - 6.**

Place of work: Gynecology and obstetrics Ward or Clinic

Purpose of practice:

Programme of placement: Student gets necessary skills of taking care of women at every age by using upto-date diagnostic methods in preventive and treatment of female reproductive system diseases. Training Student to understand and interpretation: basics of gynecology and obstetrics, principles of organization maternity care, organization preventive programs and treatment of female reproductive system neoplasms, results of laboratory tests used in gynecology.

Student who pass this practice

- 1. Takes medical history from a adult patient. Performance full physical examination. Evaluates the general condition of the patient, consciousness and awareness level. Uses Apgar scale, examine primitive reflexes.
- 2. Runs diagnostic of common diseases. Evaluates and describing the somatic and psychiatric patients state.
- 3. Student recognizes life-threatening conditions.
- 4. Student plans diagnostic, therapeutic and preventive procedures. Analyze possible side effects of therapy and drug interactions. Proposes individualization of actual guidelines and another treatment in case of non-response to drug.
- 5. Qualifies patients to hospital treatment.
- 6. Interprets laboratory test results and identifies cause of abnormalities.
- 7. Plans a procedures in case of possible blood-transmitted infection.
- 8. Takes samples for various laboratory tests.
- 9. Performs main doctor's procedures:
 - a) measurements of body temperature, pulse rate, blood pressure and respiration rate
 - b) monitoring of vital parameters by a cardiac monitor and heart rate monitor
 - c) urinary catherization, gastric lavage,
- 10. Assists to a maintaining doctor's procedures:
 - a) Blood transfusion
 - b) thoracentesis
 - c) pericardiocentesis
 - d) paracentesis
 - e) lumbar punction
 - f) needle aspiration biopsy
 - g) intradermal tests
- 11. Plans multidisciplinary consultations



- 12. Identifies agony and patient's death.
- 13. Uses basic types of surgical instruments.
- 14. Runs a patients' medical documentation.
- 15. Assists in typical surgical procedures in the operating theater, prepares operative field, uses local anesthesia.
- 16. Works using aseptic and antiseptic principles.
- 17. Gets venous catheters, performs basic life support (BLS) using defibrillator and other emergency procedures.
- 18. Interprets abnormal symptoms of complications of pregnancy (uterine contraction)
- 19. Interprets physical examination of pregnant woman result (blood pressure, mothers heart rate) and laboratory test results informing about abnormalities in pregnancy.
- 20. Interprets cardiotocography.
- 21. Recognizes start of labour and abnormal length.
- 22. Interprets signs and symptoms during postpartum period.
- 23. Student tries not to make any mistakes in his actions.
